

# PROTOCOL FOR IN-CLASS DRESS REHEARSAL WEEK

Tuesday, May 28th-Monday, June 3rd  
Location: Berest Dance Center

- During this week, in your child's regular class(es), she/he will mimic **exactly** what they will wear on the stage.
- This includes correct hair, clean and hole-free tights and shoes and undergarments that cannot be seen once in costume or dress code.
- Please plan ahead and start to take inventory now of what you may need to purchase.
- The approval or disapproval from your teacher will let you know ahead of time if you need to adjust anything prior to appearing on the Jeanne Rimsky Stage.
- Detailed requirements for each level are listed below:

**Kinderballet, Levels 1, 1a, and 2:** Costume is their dress code (make sure to label the inside of all attire and shoes). Hair must be neat ponytail.

-A hairpiece will be given to you in class to wear on the stage. This will have to be reinforced with bobby pins.

**Levels 3 and 3a:** Costume is their dress code (make sure to label the inside of all attire and shoes). Hair in ballet bun! (see our YouTube bun tutorials [HERE](#)).

-A hairpiece will be given to you in class to wear on the stage. This will have to be reinforced with bobby pins.

**Levels 4 and above:** Arrive in regular dress code for warm-up. Bring costumes, including head pieces, correct undergarments, correct tights and clean shoes. Hair in low ballet bun with a side part.
